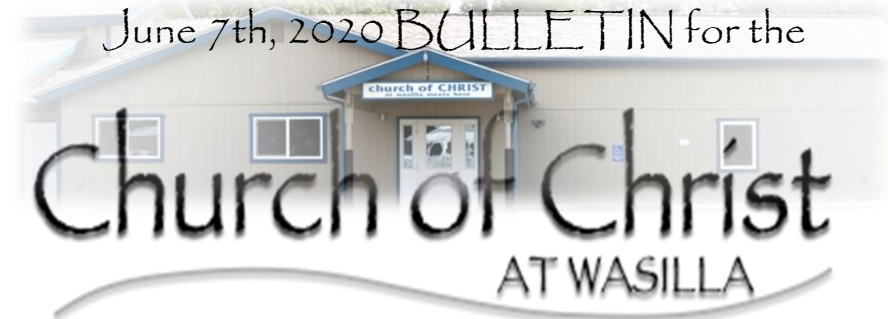

Sincere Repentance

Should it seem odd to us today at how chaotic the world is acting? From sicknesses to riots from violence to hate perpetuated by lack of concern for one another. Why is it so confusing for so many that a child who is taught their entire youth that they descend from animals begin to act like animals we are shocked? All this has its evil roots embedded in one simple fact. Man has lost his way. But this is not some new invention, this has been a problem of man for a very long time. Judges 17:6 NKJV "In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes." We for some reason continue to act this way as if we have figured everything out. And a favorite scripture of mine II Corinthians 7:10 NKJV "For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death."
