Honesty

There is a lot of disinformation being spread right now and sadly most of it is due to dishonesty. This dishonest handling of information can lead to confusion. We have an election taking place this year where ads are being ran that aren't always being truthful. We are also still fighting this virus where the information given at times is not always sincere. Most concerning is that in the "religious world" most won't be open to the truth. One of the main reasons why there seems to be so much confusion right now is because of one word dishonesty.

While the word dishonesty in the KJV comes up only 3 times. A similar word "deceived" comes up in the New Testament according to the Strong's Concord-



ance 51 times in 37 verses.
Doesn't it then seem fair to
say that God wants us to pay
careful attention to things
that could cause us confusion
or things that could deceive
us, and avoid them at all
cost? 1 Corinthians 15: 3334 NKJV "Do not be deceived:
"Evil company corrupts good
habits." Awake to righteousness, and do not sin; for some

<u>do not have the knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame."</u> In order to not be deceived we must first be HONEST. Doesn't that seem like a word that is missing from todays society, from todays discourse and most concerning from the religious world?

If Paul tells the church in Corinth do not be deceived, what does that tell us? First we obviously can be deceived but also the text suggest that we can be honest. We can be honest with text, with ourselves and with the Almighty God. The word honest according to the Strong's Concordance means to be properly beautiful but chiefly good that is valuable or virtuous. Luke 8:15 KJV "But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.: According to Luke's account of how Jesus explained the parable of the sower and the seed, Jesus tells us the good ground will have an honest heart. Isn't that a fitting and beautiful truth.

Good and honest are closely linked to each other. To be good is to be honest and to be bad is to be dishonest. **2 Corinthians 4:1-2 KJV** "Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty (shame NKJV), not walking in craftiness, nor

handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God." Paul being moved by the Holy Spirit found it necessary to remind the church in Corinth that we have a responsibility too honestly and sincerely handle the word of God. While also renouncing the dishonest motives of those who would like nothing more than to secretly teach or act shamefully. We must honestly search the scripture daily just as those in Berea with a prayerful and readiness of mind.

We also need to be honest with ourselves. This is crucial when patterning ourselves after Christ. After all we are Christians and cannot imagine Christ ever being dishonest. 1 Peter 3:10-12 NKJV For "He who would love life And see good days, Let him refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips from speaking deceit. Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it. For the eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their prayers; But the face of the LORD is against those who do evil."

Peter is taking this from Psalms specifically 34 verses 12-16.

We can easily think about David and Psalms in general, when it comes to being honest with ourselves. David beautifully and unapologetically told of his faults and his short comings. But most importantly recognizing his



need to be totally dependent on God first. We must be honest with ourselves and refrain for allowing our tongue to spread deceit. **Matthew 15: 18-20** "But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man. For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. These are the things which defile a man, but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile a man.". In order to be honest with God we are to be honest with His word and with ourselves.

During this time when dishonesty and deceit appears to reign supreme we as the church must be a light. As this light we are to be honest and good. This is what God expects from us and what we should expect from ourselves. Let us strive to be faithful, good and honest for this is Christ.
