Unhappy?

"Life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness," is one of the most well-known statements found in the Declaration of Independence. Despite the fact that this idea is at the heart of American ideas many people still find happiness difficult to achieve. Followers of Jesus should be the happiest people in the world. The Savior Himself spoke of the life He offers as being abundant (John 10:10). The apostle Paul said the spiritual mindset will be one of life and peace (Rom. 8:6). Sorrows are a part of life (cf. 1 Thess. 4:13). However the Christian has access to joy at all times because he is "in the Lord" (Phil. 4:4). Perhaps you are thinking, "I understand these things but I'm still not particular happy." If you, as a disciple of Jesus, are unhappy, then perhaps these thoughts may serve helpful...

Perhaps you suffer from "I" disease? Selfishness is often the tap root of discontentment and a lack of joy. Biblically there is a proper place for self-fulfillment (cf. Mark 12:31; Phil. 2:4), however there's a much greater stress on serving others (John 13:15; Gal. 5:13). Never underestimate the power active service and giving to others has in bringing about blessedness (cf. Acts 20:35).

Perhaps you are worried and anxious about life? Nothing zaps joy like worry, stress and anxiety. The Lord did not leave us without instruction regarding these matters. Three times in the Sermon on the Mount Jesus commanded His followers not to worry (Matt. 6:25, 31, 34). In His discourse He spoke of God's intimate knowledge of His creation, His care and His promise to provide life's needed items especially to those who seek first the kingdom (Matt. 6:33). When we trustingly place our minds on heavenly things (Col. 3:4), happiness typically is just around the corner.

Perhaps you are allowing others to affect you? It is easy to search for happiness through relationships with others. And, it would be difficult to deny that healthy relationships (spouse, relatives, friends, etc.) indeed bring a great deal of joy. However, people will and do disappoint us. If I'm waiting for a change in someone else before I can be happy I may find myself waiting forever. The same thing holds true if I am waiting for someone else to provide me joy. Therefore I must choose to work on my relationship with God first (James 4:4), making the necessary changes I can make in my own life (2 Peter 3:18) and allow these avenues to provide the happiness I desire.

Perhaps you are allowing the less important to sidetrack you from the most important? I have heard it said before that the key to life is keeping the main thing the main thing. Certainly this is true. Jesus spoke of the negative effects the cares, riches and pleasure of this life can have on the soul (Luke 8:14). Like Martha we can allow the good to crowd out the best (Luke 10:38-42) and miss out on what really matters. If unhappy, why not determine to focus on the 'one thing' that matters most (Psalm 27:4; Phil3:13-14)? Focus has a way of pushing out distractions and bringing about peace (Phil 4:6-7). (Bill Burk)

- 5. When you begin to talk about "they" when talking about the church.
- 6. When you give little of yourself Time, money and talents.
- 7. When you have no urgency for the lost. Not concerned about your neighbor
- 8. When you spend more on hobbies than on the Lord's work.
- 9. When your closest friends are either weak friends or non Christians.
