Worship

How wonderful is it to be able to worship the Creator of the entire universe. In thinking about that I am reminded of what the Psalmist wrote in [Psalms 8:1-4 NKJV](#) "O Lord, our Lord, How excellent is Your name in all the earth, Who have set Your glory above the heavens! Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained strength, Because of Your enemies, That You may silence the enemy and the avenger. When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained, What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?" How humbling it is to know that the Creator is mindful of His creation.

With that said isn't it necessary for us to consider how we approach God? Do we approach Him with the reverence He deserves? Remember this set of scripture found in [John 4:23-24 NKJV](#) "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." God's word teaches that those who approach the heavenly throne must approach it from the way God says. That is in spirit and truth. Something that might help clear up the question of whether we can or cannot worship God at our whim or by our own standard is found in [Leviticus 10:1-2 NKJV](#) "Then Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censer and put fire in it, put incense on it, and offered profane fire before the Lord, which He had not commanded them. So fire went out from the Lord and devoured them, and they died before the Lord." God does not accept worship offered in a strange way or in a way He has not commanded. What this is called is will worship. [Colossians 2:20-23 NKJV](#) "Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as though living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations— "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle," which all concern things which perish with the using—according

to the commandments and doctrines of men? These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, false humility, and neglect of the body, but are of no value against the indulgence of the flesh." This is the kind of worship that is defined by man.

If we are to worship God in spirit and in truth we must do it His way. [Hebrews 12:28-29 NKJV](#) "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire." Here we read that we are to serve God acceptably but not just by going through the motions. We are to serve God with reverence and godly fear. This obviously is not done by what we might deem acceptable but by reading His word. Remember the consuming fire that snuffed out Nadab and Abihu. Let us also remember that our God is a consuming fire worthy of proper and acceptable worship. [Romans 12:1-2 NKJV](#) "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God." This is the attitude we must have when we worship God. We are to present our bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God. Why? Because it is our reasonable service. We are to serve God His way. Not to be conformed to this world nor create our own kind of worship but simply doing things His way. Friends please don't forget, what is man that God is mindful of him. This statement might not seem like much but this is talking about the CREATOR of the entire universe. If He is mindful of man then let man worship Him the way He commands and not any other way!
