Addicted

It seems like every time we turn around someone has come up with another addiction. Years ago, the only addiction we ever heard about was drug addiction. Then alcoholism was classified as an addiction, and next it was sex addiction. It seemed that everyone that tended to do something that they knew that they shouldn't do could blame their action on an addiction. It was convenient. A person that committed adultery could claim that they couldn't help themselves because they were addicted to sex. And a person that stole could blame it on kleptomania.

To be honest I have seen addiction firsthand and it is not pretty. There was a person who worked for me as a wildland fire fighter who would steal his co-workers' lunches instead of bringing his own to work. I have seen drug addicts, alcoholics and even had a man who worked for me who, more than likely, would be diagnosed as a sex addict in today's health systems. But the issue that I have with the addiction diagnosis is that it often takes away the personal responsibility to make the right decisions.

There is an addiction that we as Christians should have and should be proud to be classified as an addict in this area. 1 Corinthians 16:13-16 (KJV) ¹³ Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. ¹⁴ Let all your things be done with charity. ¹⁵ I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,) ¹⁶ That ye submit yourselves unto such, and to every one that helpeth with us, and laboureth. Read this passage closely and you will see that Paul discusses an addiction. In verse ¹⁵ Paul says that the house of Stephanas has "addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints".

We all should be spoken of like that! The ministry of the saints should be foremost in our minds throughout the day. We should think about our brothers and sisters daily. It should be in our prayers. Which of our brothers needs a little help along the way. Pray about them, then act. What sister could use a little relief from her children on occasion? Go and pray with her, then offer to help her have a day to herself. What about that person who comes occasionally, could a little phone call or personal visit make a difference in their lives? What about setting a day each week to get with them and study the Bible together, praying for understanding, strength in the word, and courage to be more like Christ in a world that is becoming more evil daily.

Jesus spoke of love often. Who can read John 13:34-35 (KJV) "A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." and not recognize that Jesus is telling us to be addicted to the ministry of the saints. The way that the world will know that we are Christians is the love we show to, and for, each other and not by our claims of Christianity.

Do you want the church of Christ at Wasilla to be known throughout the valley, and even the state, as a group of Christian brothers and sisters? It will be known that way when we become addicted to the ministry of the Saints.
