To Whom Shall We Go

Throughout Scriptures, the teachings of Jesus who is the master teacher, there have been some hard sayings. What is meant by a hard saying is a saying that can be difficult either to understand or to apply. However, we must realize that God has never asked us or anyone to do something that they were incapable of doing. For to ask that of someone would be unjust. We have an exchange between Jesus and His apostles on this very idea. After Jesus had fed the 5,000 He began to teach those who would continue to follow after Him. During His teachings many departed leaving only the 12. At this time Jesus asks a question to which Peter has a response.

John 6:66-69 NKJV “From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more. Then Jesus said to the twelve, ‘Do you also want to go away?’ But Simon Peter answered Him, ‘Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.’”

How easy it could have been for the apostles to walk away just like the others. However, Peter rightly deduced that the words of Jesus were and are the words of eternal life. This is so important for us to remember today. Many times we find ourselves in positions that may challenge our faith. Yet, we must not allow ourselves to depart like the others but rightly understand what Peter did. I am reminded of a similar conversation that Jesus had with the Samaritan women.

John 4:13-15 NKJV “Jesus answered and said to her, ‘Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.’ The woman said to Him, ‘Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw.’”

We can easily see that there is no one to whom we should go to other than Jesus. When times get hard let us go to Jesus. When we find ourselves in difficulties let us go to Jesus. Also, let us not be ignorant and think that Jesus is only there when times are hard or we find ourselves in a bind. We must always be willing to be with Jesus to be a true disciple of His. I do want us to understand that Jesus is our Savior and we must not be ashamed to admit that. **1 Peter 4:12-14 NKJV** “Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ’s sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified.”

This is the confidence we must have in Christ. If we are reproached against or put through trials let us not be flaky followers. Let’s stand firm in the faith so that we can be counted as righteous. Not for anything we have done but because of our unwavering faithfulness to Christ. When you are confronted with the difficulties of this life we would do well to be like Peter. That is to say, You Christ, have the words of eternal life. This is how we may overcome. To put on the whole armor of God leaving nothing off. So, I ask you again to whom shall you go to in times of doubt, obstacles or trials? Will you turn to that which leads to destruction or to that which leads to everlasting life. **Matthew 7:13-14 NKJV** “Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.”
