Let us get the full picture of the True God who is the same yesterday, today, and forever more!

Psalms 103:1-22 NKJV

¹"Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! ² Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: ³ Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, ⁴Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, ⁵Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. Do we bless God and show the reverence He deserves. Look at the first benefit mentioned by David. Forgiveness of sin, without this cleansing we would be lost eternally. However, God through His love has made forgiveness possible.

⁶ The Lord executes righteousness And justice for all who are oppressed.

⁷ He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the children of Israel.

⁸ The Lord is merciful and gracious, Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.

⁹ He will not always strive with us, Nor will He keep His anger forever.

¹⁰ He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor punished us according to our iniquities. Sin separates us from God but because of His great mercy, reconciliation exist. Have you taken the time to thank God for that. Remember God wants all to come to repentance so that none would perish. Is your heart towards God or towards self?

¹¹ For as the heavens are high above the earth, So great is His mercy toward those who fear Him; ¹² As far as the east is from the west, So

far has He removed our transgressions from us. ¹³ As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him. ¹⁴ For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust. When we are right with God, we have full assurance that our sins are blotted out. This comes from a humble attitude, seeking to please God. God our Creator knows our ability. Sadly, some think because they were once able to do more in their youth but cannot now because of age, God must be angry with them. God knows our abilities, our thoughts, our intentions and so do we. We just need to be honest with our commitment to God.

¹⁵ As for man, his days are like grass; As a flower of the field, so he flourishes. ¹⁶ For the wind passes over it, and it is gone, And its place remembers it no more. ¹⁷ But the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting On those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children, This is another great benefit from the Lord. We are a forgetful people but God is not forgetful in His mercy. This blessing is refreshing to our very souls if we would apply His word to our lives.

¹⁸To such as keep His covenant, And to those who remember His commandments to do them. ¹⁹The Lord has established His throne in heaven, And His kingdom rules over all. ²⁰Bless the Lord, you His angels, Who excel in strength, who do His word, Heeding the voice of His word. ²¹Bless the Lord, all you His hosts, You ministers of His, who do His pleasure. ²²Bless the Lord, all His works, In all places of His dominion. Bless the Lord, O my soul!" It is not enough to only remember the commandments from God but we must DO them. Will we sing out His praises. Let's not allow the foolish words of those who know very little about the God of the Bible influence our commitment to Him. Remember David did not think God under the Old Testament was harsh, lacking grace, unmerciful and unloving, so why would we. Do you appreciate and thank God for how loving He is?
