

Too Comfortable

Matthew 15:8 NKJV "'These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me." It is so easy to become comfortable. Now what I mean by that is, it is easy to become lazy or feel as though nothing more is needed. Last month I found myself excited to be able to help out in a time of need. This need was working with Tom and Bill to get services uploaded online. Doing this was an encouragement since we would not be meeting together at that time. Jeremiah 17:9-10 NKJV "The heart is deceitful above all things, And desperately wicked; Who can know it? I, the LORD, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings."

Zephaniah 1:12 NKJV "And it shall come to pass at that time That I will search Jerusalem with lamps, And punish the men Who are settled in complacency, Who say in their heart, 'The LORD will not do good, Nor will He do evil." Prior to Judah falling into Babylonian captivity God was continuously reminding His people that if they where to continue in their disobedience they would fall.
