Science and the Bible

The Bible and true science have always agreed. Before humans understood how the hydrological systems worked, the Bible taught this Ecclesiastes 1:7 (KJV) "All the rivers run into the sea; yet the sea *is* not full; unto the place from whence the rivers come, thither they return again." And in that same section, Solomon discussed the weather systems by saying "The wind goeth toward the south, and turneth about unto the north; it whirleth about continually, and the wind returneth again according to his circuits." Ecclesiastes 1:6 (KJV). Before men understood the currents in the oceans, the Bible told us about them; 2 Samuel 22:16 (KJV) "And the channels of the sea appeared, the foundations of the world were discovered, at the rebuking of the LORD, at the blast of the breath of his nostrils.' Before humans knew the erosive power of water, the Bible taught us: Job 14:19 (KJV) "The waters wear the stones: thou washest away the things which grow *out* of the dust of the earth; and thou destroyest the hope of man." While humans thought that the earth was resting on things from the back of a giant to four turtles in a large sea, the Bible told us that God hung the earth on nothing; Job 26:7 (KJV) "He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing." These are just a few of the things that were taught by the Bible before men understood them and science began to teach them.

But man in his "wisdom" and search for more knowledge has abandoned the teachings of the Bible and substituted a polluted science for the truth taught us by God. In the 1940's astronomers began to discuss sending a telescope into space. But the technology wasn't available then, at that time men had not even launched a simple satellite into orbit. The origin of the Hubble Space Telescope is traced to a scientist named Lyman Spitzer who made the fires proposal in 1946. Finally launched on April 24, 1990 with a ten year life expectancy it was the ultimate expression of man's ingenuity and technology. Although having mirror issues that had to be corrected, Hubble has taken remarkable photographs of the universe. In what was one of the most surprising photos to be taken was the one named the "Hubble Deep Field Image". In this photo, the camera on Hubble was aimed at an empty part of the sky and focused on a point about the size of a dime viewed from 75 feet away. And amazingly, it found that that empty part of the universe was filled with galaxies.

Then the James Webb Space Telescope was launched and it has just recently began to send back photos. Some of these photos turned the scientific community upside down. The photos have shed legitimate doubt on the sacred cow of astronomy and evolution by photographic proof that the "Big Bang" theory cannot accurately describe the origin of the universe. So rather than providing the "proof" of the Big Bang theory as it was expected to do, it cast significant doubt that there was ever a "Big Bang" that started the universe and contributed to the creation of the stars, planets and life itself.

But rather than accepting what the photos seem to indicate, the scientific community is now trying to figure out how they can explain the photos in light of the Big Bang. It will be an interesting time as this plays out. Of course for Christians there is no issue at all. God spoke the universe into existence, He created the stars, planets and life. I wonder if there will ever be a time when people will just accept the wonder of the God created universe. I doubt that that will happen short of judgement, but one day every knee will bow and acknowledge the majesty, wisdom, and love of God.
