Faith Like Samson

One of the most interesting individuals in scriptures to me is Samson. Growing up I would always hear cautionary advice when it came to the descriptions of Samson. I would hear things like he was a womanizer, a deceiver and a reckless man. All these illustrations of his character caused me to think Samson was lost. I mean, how could someone who lived a life such as Samson did, ever be put in the same sentence with those “champions of faith” like Samuel and David. [Hebrews 11:32 NKJV](#) “And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also of David and Samuel and the prophets:” The problem we find ourselves in sometimes is that we allow others to tell us what to think instead of how to think. We would be much better off if we could remember the fact that each one of us will stand accountable to God for our own actions.

Now, before we get back to Samson let us recap the previous two articles. First we looked at Abel, how even though there is little written about him we still see his faith as an example for us. Then we looked at Sarah, we saw how we must not allow age to limit us from being faithful to God. So what do we learn about Samson. It seems to be that God doesn’t allow your past to define you. Yes, Samson lived wildly however we read about his end in a magnificent way. [Judges 16:28 NKJV](#) “Then Samson called to the Lord, saying, ‘O Lord God, remember me, I pray! Strengthen me, I pray, just this once, O God, that I may with one blow take vengeance on the Philistines for my two eyes!’” God allowed in this moment for Samson to triumph in a powerful way. How about you? Are you allowing your past to hold you back from being more faithful. If so, please know as there is still breath in your lungs you can change. Remember God’s will for us all [II Peter 3:9 NKJV](#) “The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.” Will you respond?
