This Little Light of Mine

One of my favorite songs to sing with my children is "This Little Light of Mine". When I see Rhiannon put her baby finger up as the girls are singing, my heart warms up. While we might overlook this song because of categorizing it as a "children's song", we can all learn something. This song teaches us an important truth, that is we cannot be part time Christians. Have you thought of it that way? We must always be let the light of Christ shine through our lives. Let us consider a couple scriptures that teach us part time Christianity is not what God accepts.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 NKJV "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. 'And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." Not only does this scripture clearly teach the responsibility parents have to teach their children but also teaches that this must be done everywhere. We cannot do a good job teaching our children what it means to be a servant of God by attending services on Sunday and Wednesday. Only to live worldly throughout the rest of the week.

Joshua 24:14-15 NKJV "Now therefore, fear the Lord, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the Lord! And if it seems evil to you to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land

you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Here we parallel the idea of what was taught in Deuteronomy. That is, we see we must CHOOSE God first with all our heart, soul and strength. If we are claiming to be Christian's, it starts with putting God first, that is above all else. We must also do this from sincere desires to please God.

I John 1:5-7 NKJV "This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin." We end this article by observing the fact that our light will only shine if we are walking with Christ. To walk in light is to walk in harmony with Christ. John 8:12 NKJV "Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, 'I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." Just like the song we teach our children we must also remember the words ourselves.
